







Between 2015-16 and 2022-23, Santa Clara added 78 Pell students.







In the most recent year, Santa Clara's six-year Pell graduation rate was higher than its overall six-year grad rate and higher than its peers' average six-year Pell grad rate. Santa Clara's Pell retention rate was higher than its overall retention rate but lower than its peers' average Pell retention rate.

In 2022-23, 13 percent of Santa Clara students were first-generation, and 5 percent were first-generation and received Pell.1
