Dear IPEDS Keyholder,

The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) is pleased to provide you with the 2024 IPEDS Data Feedback Report (DFR). The links to the report are included below my signature. This report is based on the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) data submitted by your institution during the 2023-24 collection cycle. The reports are accessible in both Portable Document Format (PDF) and HyperText Markup Language (HTML) web format. The PDF reports are available to download or print. The HTML reports are accessible online, allowing users to navigate through charts using key tab or mouse. The HTML reports are compliant with Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. In about two weeks, the DFR links will also be emailed to the presidents or the chief executive officers of your institution.

Please carefully review your DFR. Institutions are responsible for reporting accurate data to IPEDS. The data are publicly available in many ways, including College Navigator, the College Scorecard, the College Affordability and Transparency Center, the FAFSA online, and the IPEDS website.

Each year, institutions have the option to choose their own comparison group for the report. If your institution did not define its own comparison group, NCES selected a comparison group for you. If you would like to modify the comparison group, you may do so using the 'Data Feedback Report' functionality on the IPEDS website through the 'Use the Data' webpage (https://nces.ed.gov/ipeds/use-the-data). This functionality allows you to recreate this report with updated comparison groups, including additional figures and methodological notes. Corrections to the data submitted by your institution for the 2023-24 collection cycle can be made in the Prior Year Revision (PYR) system (https://surveys.nces.ed.gov/ipeds_py/). Note that the last day to make corrections for the fall survey components was October 13, 2024. Please use your current year UserID and password to log into the PYR system. If you do find reporting errors, ensure that measures are in place to avoid the same errors in the data you report in the 2024-25 collection cycle.
