- 1. Take care of your people first and foremost.
- 2. Remember there are at least two sides to every story. (Don't make a decision after hearing only one side.)
- 3. It's important to work hard, but don't become a work-a-holic.
- 4. Fix the problem not the blame. (Good people, making decisions, make mistakes.)
- 5. You. Take responsibility for your own bad decisions.
- 6. Back the people you have confidence in .. (and don't back the people you don't).
- 7. Your leadership style must be true to your personal style.
- 8. Unlike other commodities, information has value when it is NOT scarce.
- 9. Praise in public, criticize in private. (Feedback is important, but few bosses do it well.)
- 10. Use both affect and intellect in making decisions. (Many good decisions come from intuition.)
- 11. Be scrupulously honest and ALWAYS do what you say you will.
