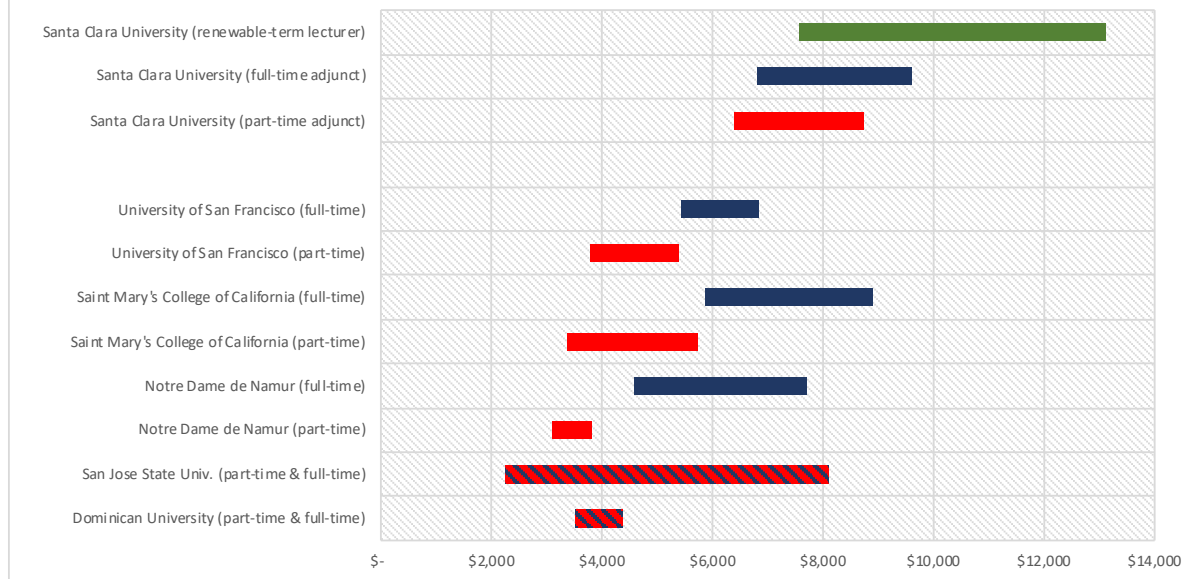


Adjunct Salaries Per Course (Scaled to 10-Week Quarters)

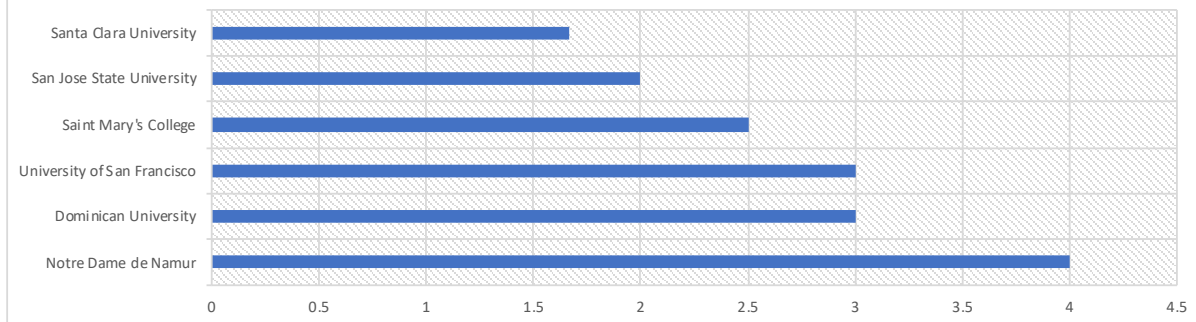

Santa Clara University operates predominantly on an academic calendar consisting of three ten-week quarters, whereas most comparable institutions run on an academic calendar built around two fifteen-week semesters. To compare adjunct salaries at institutions observing different academic calendars, the *per course* rate for one 15-week semester is multiplied by 2/3 to arrive at the equivalent of a *per course* rate for one 10-week quarter at SCU. Note that the analysis of SCU salaries includes only the salaries of adjunct faculty teaching in SCU's quarter-based programs (College of Arts and Sciences, Leavey School of Business, School of Engineering, and School of Education and Counseling Psychology); it does not include the adjunct salaries for the two schools teaching on the semester system.
