SCU IRB Committee recommendations are as follows:

For non-government supported research

- 1. IRB to continue the current practice of each institution's IRB reviews own protocols, consent, approval, etc.
- 2. Relying on a reputable institution IRB is acceptable;

<u>Note:</u> Reviewing or Recorded IRB is required to provide the following documents for SCU IRB to determine the quality /thoroughness of the protocol and whether to recommend SCU relying on the institution as the reviewing or recorded IRB to IO.

- approved protocol
- IRB approval letter
- consent form
- HS training requirements of PIs
- 3. SCU contracting a "Commercial IRB" as the IRB of record (reviewing IRB) will be on a case-by-case basis (generally not in favor of this option as a rule).
