



Bronco Kids All Sports Camp Counselor In Training (CIT)

Counselors In Training (CITs) are typically former campers between the ages of 13-17 who would like the opportunity to still be a part of the Bronco Kids All Sports Camp in a leadership role. These young adults will acquire invaluable new leadership and mentoring skills that will assist them in future endeavors.

What duties will CITs be responsible for?

- Ensuring a safe, positive, and fun environment for all campers.
- Attending and participating in a pre-camp staff training (specific days and times are TBD but are typically the Thursday prior to the first week of camp from 4-6pm).
- Assisting with setting up fields and courts for scheduled sports.
- Leading various drills for different sports.
- Picking up all sports equipment and trash at the end of activities.

What makes me qualified to be a CIT?

- Previous experience in the Bronco Kids All Sports Camp.
- Genuine interest in school age children and concern for their well-being.
- Available during work hours and training dates.
- General knowledge of a variety of sports and other recreational activities.

What is the time commitment for CITs?

We ask that the selected CITs commit to a minimum of two weeks of service (80 hours). We also ask that CITs be available for the pre-camp staff training.
