

Suggestions for Filling out Schedule Document:

Topic – Only use topic if your class has a different title than what is in the catalog. For instance, a Cultures and Ideas class will have a topic to differentiate it from other Cultures and Ideas classes.

Instructor – Please include Last Name and at least a first initial. Some departments have multiple instructors with the same last name and we can't tell which one is correct.

Room Requests –

Special Consideration – Does this instructor have a special need? If yes, please **be specific** about what the instructor needs in the Other Special Consideration Detail/Specific Classroom column.

White Board/Chalkboard – If the instructor wants a specific type of board, enter W or C.

Classroom Capture – Only request if the instructor will be using Classroom Capture.

WACOM – Only request if the instructor will be using WACOM.

Tiered Seating – Do you want seats in the tiered format.

Desks – Do you want a classroom with desks.

Tables and Chairs – Do you want a room with tables and chairs.

Back to Back – Do you have two classes with the same instructor that are back to back.

Other Special Consideration Detail/Specific Classroom column – If you have any other requests for either a specific type of classroom or a specific classroom. Use this space for any special requests. Also, if your instructor has a special concern, please be very specific about what you need for their class. **Please include ANY requests that you may have that are not considered in the other room request columns.**

Final Cap – This is what we use to find you the correct sized classroom.

Final Exam – Will this class be having a final exam. If you are not certain, enter Y.

Cross-listed with – If your class is cross-listed, please include the subject and catalog number of the class that it is crossed with.

Multi-term – If the class is taught over two quarters, then include what quarters it will be taught. *At this time, this should only be used for Cultures and Ideas and Critical Thinking and Writing classes.*
