**Subject: Special Garbage Collection (For Fee) on Wednesday, June 24
and Monday, June 29 - Residents ONLY**

The City of Santa Clara is taking a proactive approach in keeping the Santa Clara University neighborhood clean during the peak move-out time. This bulky item collection service will be taking place along your street on June 24 and June 29.

What items can I put out? Bulky items such as desks, mattresses, couches, and extra bagged garbage will be accepted. Please consider donating your unwanted items so they can be reused instead of being sent to the landfill. Visit www.recyclestuff.org to obtain information on how to donate your unwanted items. Please note that some facilities may be closed due to the Shelter-in-Place order and it is best to call first.

This service does not include pick up of construction, demolition, remodel, landscaping, or yard waste debris. These materials will be subject to a \$40.00 per cubic yard collection charge. The set-out of these materials may also result in the issuance of administrative citations. Hazardous waste such as paints, cleaners and compact fluorescent light bulbs will not be collected. For disposal of hazardous waste, make an appointment for a free drive-through drop-off at www.HHW.org.

How do I participate? Place your bulky items and bagged garbage on the street in front of your residence before 8:00 a.m. on either June 24 or June 29. Do not set out bulky items or bagged garbage prior to the evening before collection day. The bottom of this letter must be filled out and affixed to one of the items set out for collection.

How does it work? Prior to pick up, City staff will measure the bagged garbage and bulky items to calculate the disposal fee, which will be added to your monthly utility bill. For your safety and ours, please practice appropriate social distancing with cleanup staff.

How much does it cost? The cost for this service is \$2 per cubic foot for bulky items, and \$2 for each 32-gallon bag of garbage collected. No loose waste will be collected.
