Crane Lift Pre-Checklist

| Prior to any crane lift at a Santa Clara University (SCU) owned or operated building, the following items shall be completed by the SCU Project Manager or designated personnel at least 72 hours in advance: |

| A copy of the crane lift plan shall be provided to SCU EHS for review. |
| Site map indicating crane location during lift. |
| Crane technical information (e.g. Crane type, base, counterweight, range, capacity, chart identification). |
| 3. Crane Operator Certifications. |
| Crane certificate or unit test and/or examination of crane, derrick, or other material handling device over 3-Ton rated capacity. |
| 5. Crane operator certificate of liability insurance. |
| A copy of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Aeronautical Study (when applicable) due to |
| proximity of Noman Y. Mineta San Jose International Airport shall be provided to SCU EHS. |
| Notify Santa Clara University Facilities Teams: |
| 1. Building Maintenance |

| On the day of the crane lift the SCU Project Manager or designated personnel is responsible for: |
| Ensuring the building fire system is on "test" when applicable with SCU EHS. |
