Automatic External Defibrillators (AEDs)

What to do if you see someone suddenly collapse...

Check if the victim is responsive...if not, remember these three easy steps:



1. Call Campus Safety at 408-554-4444 or 911

- Have them send for help, stay on the line for further instructions



2. Start Chest Compressions if the person is not breathing normally

- Push down hard and fast on the center of the chest, keep your arms straight
- Send someone to find an AED



3. Use an AED – the AED delivers an electrical shock to restart a person's heart

- It provides voice prompts that tell you exactly what to do and will only administer a shock if needed so there is no reason to hesitate
