- My best two memories as President both involve MONEY! It's not because I am a material girl, it is because I love the feeling of knowing that one more student is getting a chance at a Santa Clara University education.
- The first of my two favorite memories is the first time I reported to the Board of Regents and informed them that the Catala Club had an Endowment of over \$23,000,000 and had awarded 31 scholarships. At least four or five of the Regents came up to me after the meeting to say that Catala Club certainly had a big impact on the University's ability to support students who otherwise wouldn't be able to attend SCU.
- My second favorite memory was the Catala Board of Directors wholeheartedly approving my desire to fund a scholarship in President Father Engh's name. With the proceeds from a beautiful evening fundraiser and contributions from the first year of Charlene's Presidency, we funded the full scholarship in one year... a record for Catala.

We had our first Catala Club service day at the Bronco Pantry. Kim Gilkey met with us and gave us a tour of the food pantry. She explained the donation process and how things are stored for easy access for the students. It is a very efficient system and very accommodating to the students' needs.

Thank you to Celeste Dier, Leslie Leonetti, Dianne Bonino and Charlene Raisch for volunteering their time. We were able to sort through several bins full of donations, check expiration dates and help organize the items for the pantry shelves.

Kim mentioned the number of students accessing the pantry is continuing to increase. This summer, they will be helping approximately 86 students.

<u>Drop Off items</u> There is a donation bin in the lobby of Campus Safety Services. The bin is available 24/7 for donation drop-offs. Most needed items include rice, macaroni and cheese, peanut butter, jelly, canned vegetables, microwavable meals (vegetarian friendly), granola bars, dishwashing sponges and dish soap, paper towels, toothpaste and toilet paper (any brand and quantity is helpful). Unfortunately, homemade items are not acceptable.
