This will be my final message to you as your president. It has truly been both an honor and a pleasure to serve you in this role. I am deeply grateful to each of you for your grace and support throughout my term and for your unwavering commitment to our work. Thank you for all you do for Catala!

Later this month, I will be succeeded by our very capable First VP, Joanie Cattermole, who will formally take the helm at our Installation Mass on May 17. Thank you for supporting her in the same generous way you have supported me.

With the help of each of you, we have had quite a two-year success story! Our energy and momentum have never been better and the results show it. We have much to be proud of. A few examples:

- The benches, which were our 75th anniversary gift to the University, were kept safe in University storage during the demolition of the Bannan building and construction of the new Sobrato building. Now rescued, they are re-installed in a beautiful location in front of the Sobrato building for all to enjoy. New willow trees included!
- Upon emergence into a new post-Covid world, we (slowly) reinstituted in-person gatherings: Board meetings, general meetings, masses and special events. We hit some speed bumps on re-entry, but girl power being what it is, we did it!
- The return of in-person lunches required a reboot in our approach there too. Congratulations to First VP Joanie Cattermole for her reinvigoration of our monthly speaker series! A few Catala favs included SCU President Dr. Julie Sullivan (a new Catala member), SCU Law Professor Ellen Kreitzburg, former San Francisco Fire Chief Joanne Hayes-White '86 and author Katie Mahon '78.
- Our monthly lunch parties do not throw themselves. My thanks to each of you who stepped up to act as hostesses in the welcome return of this fun Catala tradition. The same goes

to those who put on two gorgeous Christmas teas, another beloved Catala favorite.

No recap would be complete without a shout out to all who came together to put on our beautiful anniversary party. It was a lovely evening that, in addition to being great fun with fabulous attendance, raised over \$60,000 for us.

With Catala firing on all cylinders, we also:

- increased membership from 210 to 244 ladies, a 16% increase
- added 4 new Board members fresh energy and ideas for the road ahead
- made record gifts totaling \$115,000 to our Endowment over the last 24 months
- with the combination of our hard work, generosity, and the brilliant effort of our investment management team, Catala's Endowment over the past 2 years has grown from \$23.8 million to \$32.6 million, a 37% increase. This now increases our annual student scholarship payout to \$1,112,000, benefitting 36 Catala Scholars for all four years with an average award of \$30,889. Wow-za!

No Catala president walks this road alone. I thank each of you for joining me on the journey, and I hold each of you close in my heart for your love and support though it all.

I have been blessed with many great mentors in my life, both personally and professionally. Among my favorites is Her Majesty the late Queen Elizabeth II — a wise lady who said many wise things. Let her guidance to me be my gift to you:

- 1) Look at every situation from all angles and consider all points of view
- 2) Consider every situation in proportion to the circumstances and possible consequences
- 3) Always take the long view
