1. Eight or more units in a study abroad program (may not duplicate other coursework; usually fall of junior year)
2. Six-month full-time co-op experience in industry, usually spring of junior year and following summer (plus COEN 188 and COEN 189)
3. Six or more units of undergraduate research, usually in junior or senior year (cannot also be used as an elective)
4. Twelve or more units selected in consultation with an advisor (cannot be used to satisfy University Core requirements, but a minor or second major may be used)
5. Admission to the 5-year BS/MS program and completion of 12 or more units of graduate coursework before completing the BS – usually during senior year.
